MEAL PLANS

SeCCI will provide a light self serve breakfast and lunch on Friday. The Grey Wolf Clan will be preparing the supper for the Tribe Friday at 6PM. On Saturday SeCCI will again provide a light self serve breakfast after Sunrise Ceremony and lunch after the meeting. The tribe will provide the meat for the meal at 6PM Saturday. Please bring an ALREADY PREPARED dish to share for the tribal community supper.

CAMPING

There is plenty of space for tents and a few campers. No reservations are accepted for the elder's trailer or the bunk house. It is a first come first serve basis. Campers will pay \$10.00 per night for a space with electricity. Tents will pay \$5.00 per night for electricity. Tents are free if no electricity is used. Elders over 60 do not pay to use the elder's trailer. All others are expected to donate for the additional electric used for the weekend.

SeCCI has always had a "no animals on the Tribal Grounds" policy. However, there are some members who must bring their pets. The Grounds committee requests that if you must bring your pet, you do the following:

1. Keep pet inside your own lodge. Pets do not belong near the Council House, Elders Table, Cook Shack, or the Information Center.
2. Keep your pet on a leash when out for their daily business.
3. Take equipment & supplies to clean up after your pet's.
4. Walk your pet in the area next to the fence in front of the elder's trailer.

Tribal members are welcome to bring items they make to sell over the weekend. SeCCI will also have items for sale. We plan on crafts on Friday for those who come early, and drumming and dancing on Saturday evening. We are a teaching and educational tribe so bring your knowledge and share with the community.
